This big, friendly, rich Aussie has a touch of controlled oak with ripe melon and stone fruit flavours. The crisp finish enhances the long aftertaste. Perfect with chicken and salmon.
19. Tindalls Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc - New Zealand 13.80
A mouth filling Sauvignon, alive with tropical fruits and hints of herbaceous plant. Well structured and wonderfully fresh.
20. Sancerre Terroir - Domaine Sylvain Bailly - France 16.50
Subtle aromas of fresh herbs and elderflower. Fragrant and generous with stylish flavours and a long, fine finish. Crisp and tangy.
21. Provence Rosé - France 14.30
Delicate notes of strawberry, balanced acidity and a dry finish. A very enjoyable little pink!

41. Vina Real Rioja Cune Crianza - Spain 12.95
Strict grape selection ensures that the fruit extracts in this red are full and rich. Classic Rioja.
42. Simon Hackett Shiraz - Australia 14.60
Rich deep colour with spicy peppery aromas. On the palate there is plenty of blackberry fruit and hints of vanilla from the oak ageing.
43. Fleurie "La Madone" Albert Bichot - France 14.30
The nose is floral and fruity, with scents of iris, carnation and raspberry along with a touch of nutmeg and discrete minerality. The finish is long and flavourful with the same fruitiness as perceived on the nose.

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| 22. | <p>Helmsman Pinot Grigio - Australia</p> <p>This is not your typical Pinot Grigio. It has more fullness of flavour, with a hint of pear drops on the nose. Clean and crisp on the finish.</p> | 19.95 |
| 23. | <p>Vina Palaciega Rioja Blanco - Spain</p> <p>Discreetly dry yet fruity white Rioja that possesses a distinct lime flavour, giving it mouthwatering appeal and leaving you reaching for a second glass. Perfect with cheese dishes.</p> | 21.40 |
| 25. | <p>Villa Maria Riesling - New Zealand</p> <p>This Riesling cannot be confused with German Riesling, they are poles apart. Delightfully refreshing wine with lively, zesty aromas. The palate has intense flavours with a light crisp finish.</p> | 23.70 |
| 26. | <p>Klippenkop Chenin Blanc - South Africa</p> <p>A full bodied, balanced dry white wine which is clean and refreshing with plenty of melon and apple on the palate.</p> | 18.80 |
| 27. | <p>Picpoul de Pinet - France</p> <p>One of the oldest Languedoc grape varieties, Picpoul has recently become very popular in this country. It has a delicate nose with hints of acacia and hawthorn. The palate is fresh with structured acidity.</p> | 22.80 |
| 28. | <p>Tindalls Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc - New Zealand</p> <p>Mouth filling Sauvignon alive with tropical fruits and herbaceous hints. Well structured and wonderfully fresh. Tindalls do this white to perfection.</p> | 26.80 |
| 29. | <p>Macon Lugny "Les Genievres" Louis Latour - France</p> <p>A pale yellow colour which unveils a complex nose composed of yellow fruits such as mirabelle plum and embellished by hints of muscat. Its mouth is round and very fresh with tropical and citrus flavours.</p> | 27.70 |
| 30. | <p>Robalino Albarino - Spain</p> <p>A seductive perfume of citrus, grapefruit, lemon peel and white peach, with pronounced floral and almond notes. All that fruit and still a clean, dry finish.</p> | 23.10 |
| 32. | <p>Bon Courage Unoaked Chardonnay - South Africa</p> <p>Tropical tones with guava and melon notes. Showing fullness on the palate with more citrus and lime flavours, finishing with a clean lemon zest mouthfeel.</p> | 20.50 |
| 33. | <p>Domaine de la Beaume Viognier - France</p> <p>A warm sun drenched golden colour, a sense of fresh apricot & white peach. A full savoury slightly spicy wine which is suitable with Asian, fish and white meat dishes.</p> | 29.90 |

34. Gewurztraminer Hugel - France 33.80
The spice of Alsace and one of Famille Hugel's signature wines. It is both aromatic and extroverted through its floral and spicy notes. Gewurztraminer is an invitation to accompany a variety of spicy Asian dishes as well as smoked salmon and strong cheeses.
35. Chablis Premier Cru Vaillons Albert Bichot - France 39.30
Chablis Premiers Crus are stylish, minerally wines that are highly underrated. Drouhin are renowned for their wine making skills, and this Chablis does not disappoint. Dry, crisp, refreshing with hints of apple and pear.
37. Tyrells Old Winery Verdelho - Australia 25.90
A great food wine with aromas of limes, pineapple and spice. Rich tropical fruit and honey flavours fill the palate and are complemented by a crisp lemony finish.
38. Santenay Albert Bichot - France 47.00
The nose is redolent of white flowers (acacia) and opens on lemon and candied pineapple. The palate is rich and mineral with a nice salinity, which includes freshness and energy. The aromas of elderberries and lily are completed by citrus fruits. Subtle notes of hazelnut and gingerbread assert the personality of this terroir wine.

44. Tempranillo Castillo de Calatrava Reserva - Spain 19.65
A young fine Tempranillo with ruby red colour and cherry aromas. A smooth and easy drinking Spanish red.
45. Klippenkop Pinotage - South Africa 20.60
South Africa's classic grape showing here in an approachable, easy drinking style. Good fruit, well balanced with a pleasant soft finish.
47. Doppio Passo Primitivo - Italy 24.80
A fresh and aromatic red with an amazing concentration of plum, blackberry, cherry and chocolate flavours backed by a good balance between naturally light and soft tannins and light acidity.
48. Pepper Pot - South Africa 26.75
A South African blend of classic Rhone grapes, Shiraz, Mouvedre and Tannant. It shows the fresh fruity spice driven flavours of these varietals, with a peppery nose and cool finish – a very decent gutsy wine.
49. Cotes du Rhone Rouge Colombo & Fille - France 23.80
A new and exciting style, made in small quantities by Laure Colombo. A high quality wine, lightly pressed and matured for 8 months resulting in a wine ripe with primary fruits, which is seductively soft.
50. Tyrells Old Winery Pinot Noir - Australia 25.90
A light ruby colour, classic grape aroma and floral notes, leads to a full soft palate and long luscious finish.

51. Fleurie "La Madone" Albert Bichot - France 26.80
The nose is floral and fruity, with scents of iris, carnation and raspberry along with a touch of nutmeg and discrete minerality. The finish is long and flavourful with the same fruitiness as perceived on the nose.
52. Deen Vat No 8 Shiraz - Australia 27.80
Intense dark red colour and huge palate, it displays vanilla, ripe plums and black cherries on the nose. The palate shows intense berry and rich fruit cake characters underpinned by layers of coffee and toasty oak that carry through to a lovely soft finish.
53. Casa Del Bosque Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon - Chile 25.40
Matured in French oak barrels for 10 months. A deep red colour with shades of violet. Aromas are of blackcurrant and mulberry with spicy, smoky notes. Good fruit structure on the palate with round, soft tannins.
54. Rosso Veronese Negraro Fabiano - Italy 27.80
Pleasant and well structured red wine which is quite rich, made from partially dried grapes. Fine finish, excellent with any meat or cheese.
55. Ripasso Valpolicella Classico Superior Fabiano - Italy 31.60
Fabiano are renowned producers in the Verona. Their Valpolicella Superior has an intense nose, firm on the palate, a prestigious wine joined with roasts, grills or cheese.
56. Howard's Folly Sonhador Tinto - Portugal 33.40
Lifted fresh aromas of red berries and plummy fruit with elegant, intense, spicy fruit on the palate highlighting the cool climate characters of the Portalegre region.
57. Chateau Cantermerle 2004/05 - France 44.80
This Haut Medoc Grand Cru Classe is a perfect example of everything fabulous about Bordeaux. Graceful tannins and subtle prune fruit give real volume in the mouth. Perfect with red meat, especially lamb.
59. Cantina Di Negrar Amarone Classico - Italy 42.60
One of Italy's most respected wines. Grapes are partially dried to give the well known concentrated fruit flavour. Good with cheese.
60. Chateau Lynch Moussas 2000 - France 68.00
This Pauillac vineyard has in the last years been vastly improved. It now produces top quality claret justifying its grand cru classification. Deep dark colour when made, maturing to gently ruby. While the Cabernet predominates, Lynch Moussas has a far higher proportion of Merlot for a Pauillac making it a softer, silkier wine than its neighboring chateau.
